Happy St. Valentine's Day! Across the U.S. and in other places around the world, candy, flowers and gifts are exchanged between loved ones, all in the name of St. Valentine. There are different stories about how our present-day celebration of Valentine's Day came to be.

Most likely the true story of St. Valentine is a little gruesome: Valentine was a physician and priest living in Rome during the rule of the Emperor Claudius. Because of his Christian faith, Valentine became one of the noted martyrs of the third century. The commemoration of his death, which occurred in the year 270, became part of the calendar of remembrance in the early church of the West. Tradition suggests that on the day of his execution for his Christian faith, he left a note of encouragement for a child of his jailer written on an irregularly-shaped piece of paper. This greeting became a pattern for millions of written expressions of love and caring that now highlight Valentine's Day.

While the Saint Valentine story set the groundwork for establishing the day as a holiday for romantic love widely endorsed by Hallmark, what truly solidified the connection between Saint Valentine and love was a poem by medieval author Geoffrey Chaucer in 1375, which historians consider the origin of the "modern"

There is nothing wrong with associating romance with February the 14th. After all, marriage was the Lord's idea in the first place. There is also nothing wrong with expressing love and appreciation to family and friends. But the real story of St. Valentine is most noble: thinking of the child of your jailer, imitating the kind of love that Jesus has shown us. Even while we were sinners, Christ died for us.


