It seems a little premature for me to reflect on my 10 years in ministry, all of which has been my call to Grace in Mobile, with some additional pastoral duties at Our Savior in Mobile and throughout the circuit. But with a 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee formed and working tirelessly to prepare for a grand celebration on June 29, I feel moved to respond humbly. Over the past few months, I've been saying to myself and my wife, this is my 10<sup>th</sup> Thanksgiving Eve service at Grace, this is my 10<sup>th</sup> Christmas Eve service at Grace, this is my 10<sup>th</sup> Ash Wednesday Service at Grace, etc., etc.

I was first hesitant in observing my 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of my ordination/installation here at Grace. I remember the challenges that came my way in the ministry fresh out of Seminary. Some have been resolved by God's grace. Some challenges still exist that I haven't been able to fix. I think about that often. What is so special about these 10 years? I can understand 25 or 50 years together, but then I thought how many of us have that kind of time together? Togetherness is one of the great privileges God opened to me as a pastor. I am only 1 of 3 (out of 72 classmates) who graduated from Concordia Seminary in 2015 who are still serving their first call. These last 10 years have been such a blessing for me personally and professionally. Being a pastor and working in the context of a parish is truly a wonderful privilege.

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the people of Grace Lutheran Church are the reasons to celebrate these 10 years. This anniversary is not only a celebration of me, though I am humbled and honored, but most importantly a celebration of the pastorparishioner relationship.

People let me into their lives; the best and worst of it. I was privileged to share in their joys at the births of babies, baptisms, and marriages. People invited me to celebrate and rejoice with them on holidays, birthdays, graduations and many other good times.

Other privileges of the pastor, though for some people it is hard to see, are the times when you sit with people in their darkest moments such as times of crises; death, marital and family problems, sickness, etc. In many circumstances they look to the pastor for strength, guidance, support and presence. Indeed, these are wonderful privileges of the pastor.

My family and I are humbled, grateful and undeserving. But a celebration is in order for Grace Lutheran Church. I hope you can attend as we celebrate the great privilege of life together in Christ.


**LENT 2025: GUIDED TO THE CROSS** Lent is a season when we are guided to the cross. Throughout this holy time, we are drawn to Calvary to live in forgiveness, hope, love, peace, trust and perseverance. Each week, the services and daily devotions reveal how Christ and his cross serve as examples for us of how to live our lives for and through our crucified Lord and Savior. Sundays in Lent:

**Ash Wednesday • Guided to Forgiveness** (Colossians 1:13-14): When we confess our sins, we find forgiveness in the cross of Christ and are empowered to forgive others.

**Week 1 • Guided to Hope** When we are uncertain about what the future holds, we discover in the cross the sure hope of heaven.

**Week 2 • Guided to Love**: When we are separated from others and from God by our sin, the cross brings us together through its love.

Week 3 • Guided to Peace: With wars waging within and without, the cross settles them all with peace to body, mind and soul.



Week 4 • Guided to Trust: Plagued by doubt and competing voices, we turn to the cross to put our trust fully in the salvation won for us there.

**Week 5 • Guided to Perseverance**: When we are faced with hardship, we look to Christ on the cross who endured to the end so that we might carry on.

This memorable occasion in honor of Pastor Miller's noteworthy tenure and accomplishments is a unique opportunity to express our deep gratitude and love.


