

The Way of the Cross

A Maundy Thursday Devotional Journey

April 17, 2025

The "Way of the Cross" is a devotional journey walking us through the passion. It is rooted in the historic "Stations of the Cross" that developed during the Middle Ages, probably when pilgrims journeyed to the Holy Land marking off the sites associated with our Lord's passion and the journey through Jerusalem to the cross.

In this Maundy Thursday devotion, we will take ourselves to the very heart of the suffering of our Lord; the Passion; his "Via Dolorosa" (the Way of Sorrows); "moving" our worship from the moment of his betrayal until his burial allowing us to better understand the greatest event in history: Christ's death and resurrection, which removed the sins of all people for all time- including ours.

- Groups will depart every half hour from 4:30-7:00 pm. (4:30 being the first and 7:00 being the last group.)
- Please sign up for a start time on the sheet in the church or by calling/emailing the office.

Walk-ins are welcome but may have to wait for an opening.

- Each group will consist of about 12.
- The Journey will last approximately 45 minutes.
- We will gather in Foundation Hall for station one.
- This is a "moving" worship service and stairs will be necessary to climb (some stations will also be outside unless inclement weather.)
  - Holy Communion will be served at the final station.

This memorable occasion in honor of Pastor Miller's noteworthy tenure and accomplishments is a unique opportunity to express our deep gratitude and love.


