This week's memory verse: Psalm 56:3 When I am afraid, I put my trust in you.


This Month's Memory Prayer: A Prayer for Our Nation in Lutheran Book of Prayer



Should guests so desire, a donation payable to Grace Lutheran designated "10th Anniversary" may be included with the response card and will be gratefully accepted.




