We always pray for the visible and invisible Church on this earth as we confess the Communion of Saints and pray for the day when divisions will cease.

I invite our new members or any members who never took my new member class to join me on Thursday evenings starting May 15 where we actually address our history and some of the divisions in our Church bodies and where we can find unity for the sake of the Gospel.

Jesus is our Lord. He is our Leader throughout the generations for all people and places. But Pope Leo XIV and I do have 3 things in common: we are both Christians, we are both from the southside of Chicago, and we are both Cub fans! I kind of like this Leo.

Christ is Risen! He is Risen, indeed. Alleluia!




