This weekend is open to all members of all ages (minors must have a guardian.) If you can't spend the entire weekend, come out Saturday for the day or Sunday morning worship on Perdido Bay. There is no cost! Grace Lutheran has been a partner of Camp Dixie Ministries since they opened in 1952.

This weekend will feature classic camp activities such as kayaking, swimming, games, relaxing, campfire songs and devotions. Camp Dixie Director, Sam "Uno" Schmidt, will lead us through the weekend's schedule and activities, equipping all of us to spend good old-fashioned quality time at Camp Dixie. There will also be plenty of down time and flexibility to fit you or your family unit.

Arrival on Friday between 3-6 pm. Clean up/ Check out Sunday by 2 pm.

Lodging will be in the Retreat Center bunk rooms with other campers separating males and females.

CAMP DIXIE FACILITIES

- Lodging Dorms and Indoor Gathering Space/Dining Hall are Air-Conditioned!
 - Four dormitories (2 male and 2 female); 12 twin bunk beds each.
- Includes bunks and mattresses (bring your own linens or bedding and pillow)
 - Each wing has two bathrooms with toilets, sinks, and showers.
- Large commercial style kitchen equipped with pots and pans and utensils for meal preparation.
 - Refrigeration Space and Ice Machine for use.
- Outdoor facilities include picnic tables, benches, a campfire area and an outdoor worship area.
 - 275 feet of waterfront on Perdido Bay and 8 acres of wooded area.

(There is a propane grill on site. Propane will be provided.)

New Facility Use Policy

July 30, 2026

Grace is blessed to have welcoming spaces where our congregation can gather for worship, fellowship, learning, and service. Earlier this year, Grace's Church Council commissioned a facility use committee to develop clear guidelines for the use of church facilities, including the newly added Espejo House, so these spaces can be shared with care and respect.

The adopted policy is designed to support safety, stewardship, thoughtful scheduling, and respectful use of all church spaces. In that spirit, it will help Grace:

- care well for the facilities entrusted to us
- make scheduling consistent for all groups
- keep our shared spaces safe, welcoming, and ready for ministry

As part of this policy, those requesting use of church facilities will be asked to:

- schedule use of space in advance through the church office
- complete a Building Use application/agreement, available in the church office, for member-sponsored events
- clean up after use, return rooms to their original condition, and care responsibly for church property

Copies of the new policy are available in the church office. We invite you to review the policy before requesting use of church facilities, and to contact Debbie Milling, Marilyn Griffin, or Juie Harvey with any questions or feedback. Thank you for helping Grace care faithfully for the spaces we share!
